



## Heelands School Pupil Premium Report 2019-20

The school allocation for 2019-20 was £35,720.

This included funding for 31 eligible PP pupils, which was 30% of the school population:  
10 pupils in Year 2, 10 pupils in year 1 and 11 pupils in FS.

Despite continuing to offer incentives of a free school fleece, free school trips and free after school clubs we know that we have many disadvantaged families who are unable to, or choose not to, claim their entitlement and governors feel strongly that all financially disadvantaged children should be supported in order to achieve their potential and enjoy the same experiences as their peers. We know our families extremely well and the good relationships that we have with parents make identifying need, wherever that may be, much easier.

**In 2019/20 our Pupil Premium allocation was spent on:**

£19,334	Providing a non-class based SENCo for group intervention work, to support class teachers with Achievement Plans, to ensure that PP pupils are on track to meet their targets and to provide quality first teaching support.	No national assessments took place in 2020 due to Covid-19
£2,420	Ride High 8 week programme	PP/LAC children attended a riding group providing them with an enhanced experience outside school and widening their horizons. End of course data showed improved scores in all five SEMH areas including confidence and self-esteem.
£10,032	Universal Infant Free School Meals for PP children	UIFSM money taken from PP budget
£154	Free school fleeces	Families supported financially, pupil identity and self-esteem enhanced
£900	Free milk provided for all children at lunchtime	Pupil's diet and health improved, develop awareness of healthy options
All children in school attend free after school clubs. No visits or workshops took place in Autumn 2019 that parents were asked to pay for.
