PE and School Sports Grant
2020-21

Our school's allocation for 2020/21 was £16,740. The Covid pandemic and consequent school shutdowns meant that a greater proportion of this revenue was unable to be spent and schools were allowed to carry forward unspent balances into the new school year. We have continued to provide specialist tuition in all areas of physical education including dance and gymnastic tuition for EYFS pupils.

This year the funding has been used to:

- Employ specialist coaches to teach gymnastics and dance
- Continue to offer a range of different after school activities each half term
- Provide free clubs after school for KS1 pupils to support inclusion
- Purchase specialist PE equipment e.g: safety mats, FS bicycles
- Restock lunchtime equipment

Impact of the PE and Sports Grant:

- Enhanced enthusiasm for PE across the school
- Improvement in skills monitored by coaches and staff
- Virtually 100% of KS1 pupils attended after school clubs for the maximum time
- Improved attendance at clubs as pupil confidence and enjoyment grew
- Pupils experience a wide range of activities eg hooping, games, gymnastics,
- Several pupils playing for local under seven and under eight football team
- Very confident dance performances demonstrated in productions
- EYFS pupils experience PE, dance and fitness earlier
- EYFS pupils have easier transition into KS1 PE curriculum
- EYFS pupils' listening and concentration skills improved, (assessed by coaches in comparison to other MK schools)
