Welcome to the second half of the school year. We have already completed one and a half terms, and it's so encouraging to see the progress the children have made since September, and how they have grown in confidence. **Parents' Evenings on 28th and 29th March** will give all families an opportunity to find out more about the children's learning and to see some of the work they have produced and are proud of.

You will all be aware of the strike days that have become a feature of several key sectors, and which now include teaching. Teachers' rights to union membership and choice to take industrial action are supported and protected by Employment Law. However, we also understand how difficult it can be for our working parents not to know for sure until the day of a strike whether a school will be open or fully staffed. Teacher strike days in our region and nationally are currently planned for 1st, 15th and 16th March. Please check your phone for a 7.30 am text to confirm whether school will be open on those dates. I apologise this won't be able to happen any earlier, due to the need to follow DfE guidance.



Winter illnesses have reached significant levels this year, and this has had an understandable impact on the children's overall attendance. However, we are required to closely monitor the attendance of all our children, as days missed can affect learning.

Low attendance can also have an impact on children's confidence and wellbeing. We want all children to feel secure, happy and supported to achieve at school and value your help in this. If your child is not well enough to attend, please let us know. Otherwise, we need to work together to encourage good attendance and punctuality for every child at Heelands.

Heelands has been selected at random to participate in a pilot testing trial of Key Stage 1 English grammar, punctuation and spelling assessments. This is being carried out by the NFER (National Foundation for Educational Research) and the trial will take place during the first two weeks of the summer term with the majority of our Year 2 pupils. **Thursday 2nd March is World Book Day.**
