

Heelands School PE and School Sports Grant 2015-16

Our school's allocation for 2015/16 was £8,402. We continued to provide specialist tuition in all areas of physical education including dance across the school. Teachers have also continued to develop their expertise in PE by teamteaching and working alongside the coaches.

The funding has been used to:

- Employ specialist coaches to teach gymnastics, dance and games
- Provide a lunchtime coach twice a week to improve participation in physical activity
- Further increase the range of After School Clubs offering a choice of four activities each half term
- Develop teacher expertise and confidence in delivering PE
- Replace PE equipment
- Pay for an area of artificial turf to extend all-weather use of the school grounds

Impact of the PE and Sports Grant:

- improved and enhanced enthusiasm for PE
- improvement in skills monitored by coaches and staff
- greater proportion of pupils attending After School Clubs, 98% of KS1 pupils attend
- wider range of activities offered including musical theatre, golf, volleyball,
- 100% of pupils take part in lunchtime activity sessions
- pupils take part in intra-school competitions and personal challenges
- teacher skills improved evidenced in lesson observations and CPD feedback
