

Heelands School PE and School Sports Grant 2016-17

Our school's allocation for 2016/17 was £13,326. We continued to provide specialist tuition in all areas of physical education again including dance tuition for our EYFS pupils.

This year the funding has been used to:

- Employ specialist coaches to teach gymnastics, games and dance
- Further increase the range of After School Clubs offering a choice of four different activities each half term
- Provide free of charge clubs after school all year to support inclusion
- Develop teacher expertise and confidence in delivering PE
- Purchased a further area of artificial turf to extend all-weather and all year round use of the trim-trail

Impact of the PE and Sports Grant:

- Enhanced enthusiasm for PE across the school
- Improvement in skills monitored by coaches and staff
- Continued interest in sports, 95% of KS1 pupils attended After School Clubs
- Improved attendance at clubs as pupil confidence and enjoyment grew
- Pupils experiencing greater range of activities eg tennis, archery, streetdancing, cheerleading
- Several pupils playing for local under seven and under eight football team
- Two pupils playing for professional club's junior league
- EYFS pupils exposed earlier to PE, dance and fitness earlier than previous cohorts
- EYFS pupils have easier transition into KS1 PE curriculum
- EYFS pupils' listening and concentration skills improved
- Trim Trail now available for all weather use
