



Heelands School Pupil Premium Report 2018-19

Our allocation for 2018-19 was £35,650.

This included funding for 27 eligible PP pupils, which is 21% of the school population: 9 pupils in Year 2, 8 in year 1 and 10 in FS.

Despite continuing to offer incentives of a free school fleece, free school trips and free after school clubs we know that we have many disadvantaged families who are unable to or choose not to claim their entitlement and governors feel strongly that all financially disadvantaged children should be supported in order to achieve their potential and enjoy the same experiences as their peers. We know our families extremely well and the good relationships that we have with parents make identifying need, wherever that may be, much easier.

In 2018/19 our Pupil Premium allocation was spent on:

Impact

Outcomes of each PP cohort and those of our original PP pupils are detailed below compared to 2019 national figures.
