



**Heelands School**  
**PE and School Sports Grant**  
**2018-19**

Our school's allocation for 2018/19 was £16,830 plus a brought forward balance of £10,320. We have continued to provide specialist tuition in all areas of physical education again including dance and gymnastic tuition for EYFS pupils.

**This year the funding has been used to:**

- Employ specialist coaches to teach gymnastics, games and dance
- Continue to offer a range of different after school activities each half term
- Provide free of charge clubs after school all year to support inclusion
- Develop teacher expertise and confidence in delivering PE
- Enhance the outdoor accessibility for EYFS through provision of a new all-weather shelter, bike shed, and improved paving
- Purchase specialist PE equipment e.g: springboard, soft cylinder, gym mats, large soft balls, small apparatus
- Restock and expand the range of lunchtime equipment

**Impact of the PE and Sports Grant:**

- Enhanced enthusiasm for PE across the school
- Improvement in skills monitored by coaches and staff
- Greater proportion of KS1 pupils attended After School Clubs
- Improved attendance at clubs as pupil confidence and enjoyment grew
- Pupils experience greater range of activities eg tennis, football, street-dancing, Salsa, cheerleading, athletics, gymnastics,
- Several pupils playing for local under seven and under eight football team
- Very confident dance performances demonstrated for parents and assemblies
- EYFS pupils experience PE, dance and fitness earlier
- EYFS pupils have easier transition into KS1 PE curriculum
- EYFS pupils' listening and concentration skills improved, (assessed by coaches in comparison to other MK schools)
- Pupils have suitable all-weather outdoor space
